

La Llave Asturiana



Aim of the game: To hit directly the wings of La Llave (The Key) with The Fichas (Tokens) without them touching the ground.

Set up: This game should be played in any flat outdoor area.

Basic rules:

- Throwing the tokens takes place from a distance of 8 meters.
- It can be played individually or in groups of various numbers, who take it in turns to play.
- When they throw, the players try to hit the crosses of the key. Each cross has got an assigned score due to its difficulty: one point for the biggest, two for the medium one and three points for the smallest.
- The player throws ten times, until he has used up his ten tokens.
- The winner is the player or the team that gets the highest score.

Other rules and variations:

- Throwing can take place from a longer distance of 14 meters.
- The game consists in throwing six tokens (500 up to 600g.) and striking some of the lateral “keys” or the central “nail”.
- Six tokens are thrown in each throwing, instead of ten.
- Ten throws are played. You score only in a row if you turn from the biggest to the smallest cross and so on. All the points are added up and the winner is the team with most points.



Equipment and Materials: 1 piece of iron with three crosses : La Llave (The Key) and At least 10 round flat pieces of metal : the Fichas (Tokens).

Age:
6 to 80

Number of players:
1 - 4 in each team.

Duration:
Unlimited

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Teaching Style

1. Provide clear and simple instructions
2. Balance the ability level of the team
3. Practice games before introducing scoring
4. Encourage players to communicate throughout the game
5. Provide enough time for players to familiarize themselves with the equipment and the game
6. Safety instructions to be tailored to the environment and participants playing the game

Equipment

1. Increase/decrease the weight of the Fichas
2. Use plastic Fichas.
3. Use audible equipment to mark La Llave
4. Brightly colored equipment can be used

Rules

1. Use lighter Fichas
2. Make the distances shorter for children
3. Allow more throws for children



Environment

1. Increase/decrease the distance between the thrower and La Llave
2. Ensure the outdoor playing area is flat and big enough
3. Be careful that the players who are not throwing stand behind the thrower



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
