

Las Tabas



Aim of the game: To throw a small ball in the air, pick up little bones with the same hand then, catch the ball that is falling down.

Set up: The bones have to be thrown on the ground or on a table before the ball is thrown.

Basic rules:

“Unos, doses, treses y cuatros”

First the player throws the bones to the ground. Then he throws the small ball, called “comodín” in the air. Afterwards he catches immediately one of the bones and the small ball that falls down. All this must be done with the same hand. When the player is successful he passes the bone to our free hand and go on until all eight bones are caught one by one.

Once this first turn is finished, we go to the more difficult phases: “doses” or the “twos” where players must pick up the bones, two by two. Afterwards we try with the “threes” which mean to catch three at the same time. In “fours”, the player must take four bones twice to finish the game.

Any mistake in collecting the bones or catching the “comodín”, you loose your turn and have to go back to the beginning of the game. The first player who completes “the fours” will win.



Equipment and Materials: One small ball (“comodín”) and 8 bones (real or made of plastic).

Teaching Style

1. Provide clear and simple instructions
2. Provide enough time for players to familiarize themselves with the equipment and the game.
3. Practice games before introducing scoring

Equipment

1. Colored equipment can be used. First catch the yellow, etc.
2. Audible equipment can be used

Rules

1. Increase/decrease the number of players
2. When a player reaches an new level (2nd,3rd or 4th), he may starts again not from the beginning (level 1) but from the highest level he reached.



Environment

1. Increase/decrease the size of the ball
2. Increase/decrease the size of the bones and their number
